## **Unexpected Difficult Intubation**

## **Basic Rules**

Ensure adequate level of anaesthesia and muscle paralysis
Use laryngeal pressure or BURP



Maintain oxygenation, ventilation and anaesthesia

Call for help

## Failed Intubation Plan A\*

Use improved direct laryngoscopic technique/conditions or Use indirect laryngoscopic technique Limit to 2 intubation attempts



Maintain oxygenation, ventilation and anaesthesia

Consider surgery with LMA

## **Failed Intubation Plan B**

Insert LMA
Perform fiberoptic tracheal intubation through the LMA
Limit to 2 intubation attempts

Failed

Maintain oxygenation, ventilation and anaesthesia

Wake-up



Ventilate through LMA



Emergency surgery with LMA

<sup>\*</sup>Rapid sequence induction intubation – Ensure deep anaesthesia and paralysis, oxygenate and ventilate via face mask or via LMA
